

Batty Langley Lodge

Sleeps 2 - Castletown Demesne, Leixlip, Co Kildare

An elegant two storey building with seven stone pinnacles, Batty Langley Lodge was designed to be viewed from the River Walk below as part of the planned landscape surrounding the world famous Palladian Castletown House.

It is situated on the old Dublin entrance to Castletown House, now a quiet country lane. It is far removed from the hustle and bustle of normal every day life. A perfect place to relax while still being able to get in to Dublin city within an hour.

History:



Thomas Conolly and Lady Louisa inherited Castletown in 1754 and turned Castletown demesne into one of the great designed landscapes of Ireland, visited and admired by both foreign and native visitors until its period of decline in the nineteenth century

Based on a design for a 'Gothick Temple' taken from Batty Langley's book Gothic Architecture published in 1747, the façade of the lodge was added to the existing rectangular cottage in 1785. Thus the lodge became known as the 'Batty Langley Lodge'.

Situated far from the town of Celbridge and on the very edge of the estate, the buildings privacy made it a suitable location for the privileged nobility to indulge their fantasies and escape to the lodge to don the mask of simple farmwives or dairymaids.

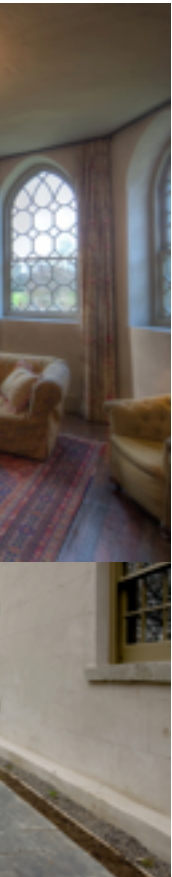
This lodge accommodates 2 people in great comfort with a large sitting room overlooking the river and a kitchen dining room downstairs and a double bedroom and bathroom upstairs.

Thomas Conolly et Lady Louisa héritèrent du domaine de Castletown en 1754 et le transformèrent en l'un des plus beaux endroits d'Irlande, visités et admirés par les visiteurs étrangers et les Irlandais jusqu'à sa période de déclin au XIXe siècle.

Sa conception est basée sur le modèle d'un Temple Gothick inspiré du livre 'Gothic Architecture' de Batty Langley publié en 1747. La façade du pavillon a été ajoutée à la maison rectangulaire existante en 1785. Ainsi, la loge a pris le nom de «Lodge Batty Langley».

Situé loin de la ville de Celbridge et à la frontière du pays, la propriété privée est un emplacement idéal pour la noblesse, et permit à cette loge de ne pas être une simple maison de fermier.

Cette maison peut accueillir 2 personnes dans un grand confort avec un grand salon donnant sur la rivière, une salle à manger au rez de chaussée, une cuisine, une chambre double et salle de bains à l'étage.
